Proposals due December 1, 2008

Purpose: To support writing in the K-12 classroom.

Amount: Ten NWP/ASWC Mini-Grants of up to \$200 each.

Deadline: Proposals must be submitted by December 1, 2008. Proposals should be postmarked no later than that date.

Proposal Requirements:

- Grant applicants must be a teacher employed by FNSBSD or YKSD or a UAF intern.
- Individuals or groups may submit proposals.
- Grants should be submitted for the actual cost of the program, not to exceed \$200.
- Each application will be judged on its own merits.

Applications must include:

- Purpose of the project
- Potential outcomes
- Budget
- Your contact information

Ideas for Proposals:

- Books which support student writing
- Book publishing materials
- Writers notebooks
- Guest Authors
- Using technology to support writing

Additional Information:

- Grant recipients will be asked to submit a reflective piece about their project for publication on the ASWC website.
- Should a recipient not complete the project, it is expected that the grant funds will be returned to NWP/ASWC.
- Grant funds must directly benefit students in writing literacy.
- Grant recipients will be required to fill out a W-9.

Is budget realistic and accurate?.....10 points

Can this project be replicated?25 points

Will project directly impact students? ...25 points
